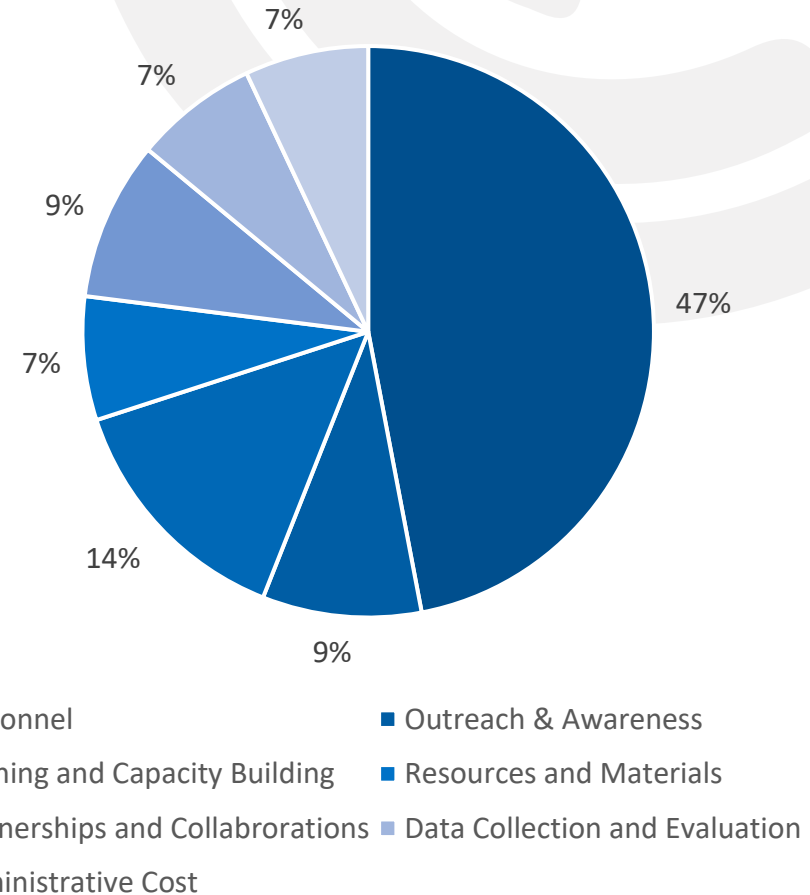

ESTIMATED PROJECT BUDGET
